THE SECRET GARDEN (PG) | Fri 30 Jul - Sun 1 Aug | Wed 4 & Thu 5 Aug

Frances Hodgson Burnett's classic children's tale is brought back to the big screen in this stellar new adaptation featuring Colin Firth and Julie Walters.

NASHVILLE (15) | Fri 30 Jul - Sun 1 Aug

Taking place over five days in Nashville in the lead up to a political convention, secrets and lies are exposed by a series of intersecting stories.
