BELFAST (12A) | Fri 21 Jan – Thu 3 Feb

★★★★★ – **Guardian**. Starring Jamie Dornan, Ciarán Hinds and Judi Dench, Kenneth Branagh's semi-autobiographical tale focuses on a young family torn between their home and fleeing the increasingly violent spectre of The Troubles in 1960s Belfast. On the cusp of adolescence, young Buddy must navigate a landscape of working-class struggle, sweeping cultural changes, and increasing sectarian violence. He finds comfort in his charismatic parents and spry, story-telling grandparents. Tender, poignant and beautifully shot in lustrous black and white. LICORICE PIZZA (15) | Fri 14 – Thu 27 Jan

"★★★★★ – every casual line, kiss, automobile-ride, set-up and joke is a joy" – **Guardian**. Set in 1970s California, Paul Thomas Anderson's (**Punch-Drunk Love**) wonderful coming-of-age story focuses on high school student and child actor Gary Valentine (Cooper Hoffman, son of the late Philip Seymour Hoffman) and his relationship with twentysomething Alana Kane (Alana Haim). COW (12A) | Fri 21 – Thu 27 Jan

★★★★ – **Guardian**. With a cold industrial setting and some joyous moments, Andrea Arnold (**American Honey**) documents the life of a single dairy cow on an industrial dairy farm in rural England, following her through her daily routine. Very little is said, yet Arnold's use of a fly-on-the-wall approach captures the plight of a cow by putting the audience in the barn with her – on her eye level – and suddenly the seemingly vacant stares become much more poignant. MY NEIGHBOUR TOTORO (U) | Sat 22 – Sun 23 Jan

"★★★★★ - a captivating world you won't want to come home from" – **Guardian**. Released over three decades ago, Studio Ghibli's delightfully whimsical animation is a timeless, heart-warming classic. When Satsuki finds that her little sister, Mei, is missing, she seeks help from the magical spirits – 'Totoros' – who inhabit the forest. A perfect snapshot of childhood wonderment.
