#### **DOWNTON ABBEY: A NEW ERA (PG) | Screening until Thu 19 May**

★★★★ – Telegraph. With the arrival of the 1930s, Downton Abbey enters the modern world as Lady Mary opens the doors to a film crew who want to use the Crawley family's historic home as a set. Meanwhile, the Dowager (Maggie Smith) reveals a secret from her past, leading the Crawley family to the South of France to a villa she's inherited under mysterious circumstances.

#### **CASABLANCA BEATS (12A) | Fri 13 – Thu 19 May**

★★★★ – Evening Standard. A joyful, exuberant journey through real-life conflicts in the Casablanca district of Sidi Moumen, Morocco. Featuring a cast of non-professionals playing fictionalised versions of themselves, **Casablanca Beats** has the perfect storm of youth, music and rebellion to inspire and invigorate us all.

#### **PRAYERS FOR THE STOLEN (15) | Fri 13 – Mon 16 May**

★★★★ – Guardian. Three Mexican girls grow up in the shadow of tensions between police, military and cartel members in their village. The harsh realities their community faces dawn on them little by little as they grow into young women.

#### **THE DROVER'S WIFE: THE LEGEND OF MOLLY JOHNSON (15) | Fri 13 – Thu 19 May**

★★★★ – Eye For Film. Leah Purcell reimagines Henry Lawson's classic Australian story through an indigenous, feminist lens, and gives a brilliant performance as Molly Johnson, a sheep drover's wife and fearsomely independent bushwoman.

#### **SONIC THE HEDGEHOG 2 (PG) | Sat 14 & Sun 15 May**

★★★★ – The Upcoming. Speedy blue hedgehog Sonic is back and levelling up the adventure for round two! Dedicated to proving he is a true hero, Sonic takes on Doctor Robotnik in a race to prevent a mystical emerald falling into the hands of evil and destroying the world.

#### **THE WALL OF SHADOWS (12A) | Sat 14 – Mon 16 May**
